Small Grant Proposal Instructions

Requirements in a proposal for the award of an RMP Small Grant of up to \$5,000 are the following:

1. Project addresses malaria control/elimination through one or more actions;
2. Has the sponsorship of host country/local Rotarians;
3. The proposing Rotary club is in good standing with Rotary International;
4. There is substantial local and/or international financing – at least equal to the grant sought from RMP, with all other sources of funding identified;
5. Provides for sustainability of project impacts over the long run;
6. Includes the objectives to be achieved and the means by which those objectives will be measured;
7. Specifies the number of direct beneficiaries of the project;
8. Provides adequate budgetary detail. Identify all sources of income, including “in kind” contributions. Expenses identified including how RMP funds will be expended. The project needs to make sense from a financial point of view.
9. Provides for acknowledgement of RMP’s support of the project.

Additional consideration will be given to proposals that

1. Involve other strategic partners;
2. Serves as a model for scaled up malaria control/elimination;
3. Expands the involvement of Rotarians in malaria control/elimination.
